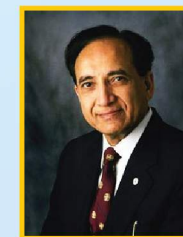

International Faculties



Prof. Jatin P. Shah

Professor Jatin P. Shah is a Professor of Surgery, at the Weil Medical College of Cornell University, and Chief of the Head and Neck Service, Leader of the Head and Neck Disease Management Team, and holds The Elliott W. Strong Chair in Head and Neck Oncology at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in New York. Prof. Shah is a national and international leader in the field of head and neck

surgery, having served as President of The New York Cancer Society, The New York Head and Neck Society, The Society of Head and Neck Surgeons, The North American Skull Base Society and the International Academy of Oral Oncology. He is Founder of the International Federation of Head and Neck Oncologic Societies, (IFHNOS) in 1986. He currently serves as Chairman of the AJCC task force on Head and Neck. He has been continuously listed in the "Best Doctors in America" directories for several years. He serves on the Editorial and Review Boards of 18 scientific journals and has published over 500 peer-reviewed articles, 78 book chapters and 10 books. He is a much sought after speaker who has delivered over 1200 scientific presentations including, 87 eponymous lectures and keynote addresses.



Prof. Greg Randolph

Professor of Otolaryngology–Head and Neck Surgery, Harvard Medical School Claire and John Bertucci Endowed Chair in Thyroid Surgical Oncology, Harvard Medical School.

Dr. Randolph has focused the bulk of his research on recurrent laryngeal nerve anatomy, preservation and monitoring during thyroid cancer surgery with focus on importance of laryngeal exam, recognition of lymph node metastasis and revision cancer surgery and has over 165 peer reviewed publications.
